Lord willing, we will be sending these out bi-monthly now since things are entirely too busy to attempt to condense three months into one sheet of paper! That being said, this letter is a month late now. We truly appreciate your patience and understanding - Google and Microsoft changed some of their requirements for mass emailing, so the majority of our prayer letters were never reaching our supporters. This has been happening for several months now. Praise the Lord, we think that we have finally been able to resolve the issue - hopefully. God willing, our next prayer letter will be sent out at the end of this month for March and April.



Praises

God has already opened so many doors of ministry this year! In January, an evangelistic team came over from the States. Brother Pelletier has been involved in assisting and facilitating national ministry in Liberia for nearly several decades now, and since I've known him since I was a very small boy, I was able to be a part of that. We were able to visit several schools, both government public schools and private Christian schools, to preach the Gospel and present Bibles from our literature container project. Many students accepted Christ and received their very own Bibles. As we were visiting the schools and villages that they had been planned to visit, word quickly spread and opportunities to preach and distribute Bibles in other schools continue to arise. Praise God for open doors! Considering how hard it can be to simply speak the name of Jesus in schools in the States, the widely swinging doors of opportunity here for the Gospel can be stunning! The love of Christ is the only thing that will bring true, lasting, positive change to Liberia - and it has to grip the hearts of the next generation of Liberians or the Charismatic movement and the massive influx of Muslim influence will sweep this country into deeper Spiritual darkness. All glory to God, I was able to personally lead twenty-eight young Liberians to Jesus during this trip, and many, many more made professions of faith.

There was also a Bible conference with the national mission we were working with, New Testament Baptist Mission headquartered in New Jerusalem township. I was blessed with the opportunity to preach several times at the conference. It was an encouraging, thoroughly uplifting gathering, and Elisabeth's first Liberian conference experience!

In February, we were blessed to join some missionary friends of ours, Bruce and Amanda Stuart, for a marriage conference in Yourpea Old Town, an interior town in Nimba County near the border with the Ivory Coast. I was blessed to be able to teach in the conference, as well as partake in some further public school outreaches where we preached the Gospel and distributed school materials and more Bibles. We stayed in Nimba ten days - it was Elisabeth's first opportunity to experience life in a village, and it was a blessing and encouragement to see her do so well!
